



PASTOR'S NOTE

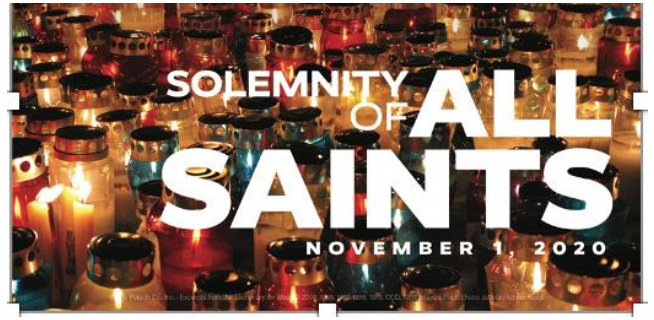
"The souls of the just are in the hand of God," (Wis 3:3)

November 2nd is the Commemoration of All of the Faithful Departed, or All Souls. During the whole month of November, the Church commemorates the souls of all the baptized who have died and who do not yet enjoy life with God in heaven. The theological underpinning of the feast is the acknowledgment of human frailty. Since few people achieve perfection in this life but, rather, go to the grave still scarred with traces of sinfulness, some period of purification is necessary before a soul comes face-to-face with God.

The Council of Trent affirmed this purgatory state and insisted that the prayers of the living can speed the process of purification. The prayers, alms, sacrifices, and Mass offerings for souls on earth can benefit these souls. The Old Testament recounts that the deceased benefit from temple sacrifice made on their behalf, *"It is, therefore, a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins (2Maccabees12:45-46)."*

When the Sacrifices are offered, it is like the fire mentioned in the book of Wisdom *"As gold in the furnace, God will prove us, purify us, and take us to himself... we shall shine... and we shall abide forever with God in love..."* St. Catherine spoke beautifully of the fire of purgatory as *"God's love burning the soul until it was wholly aflame -- with the love of God."* Taking this into account the prayers for the dead were offered by Christians from the very earliest years of the Church. The walls of the Christian catacombs of Rome were crowded with innumerable marble plaques in succinct Latin praying for the dead. There has never been a time when the Church has not commemorated, remembered, and prayed for the dead.

Taking into account Catholic tradition, St. Patrick's Parish encourages everyone to remember all those who have been part of your life and have gone before you; and most importantly, to thank Our Lord, the source of life, for them. Please join us in the celebration of the Eucharist daily in the month of November as we remember all our loved ones.
